 - Letters should cite examples of how the nominee has contributed to the improvement of southern Illinois residents.
3. Pertinent documentation or supporting evidence addressing the following points:
 - Volunteer activities
 - Demonstration of commitments to healthy families and health communities
 - Results of contributions
4. Please DO NOT include activities that are part of the nominee's job duties unless there is a clear extenuating circumstance.
5. Applications are "blinded" when sent to the selections committee. Please use "she" and "her" instead of the nominee's name.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- Nominees will be considered without regard to race, religion, or background.
- Nominees must be 18 years of age or older (as of 1/1/2017).
- Nominees must be a resident of southern Illinois for a minimum of five (5) years.
- Steering Committee members of the Southern Illinois Women's Health Conference and the Southern Illinois Women's Teen Conference may be nominees.
- Members of the Board of Directors of Women for Health and Wellness, Inc. and the Rosemary Berkel Crisp Award Selection Committee may not be nominees.
